Summer Math

Dear New Students and Families:

Welcome to Palma School!

We would like to introduce you to our online summer math program to help students review and prepare for the fall semester. Each assignment is designed to be a review of basic mechanics or concepts that students have learned either this year or in previous math classes.

As a department, the math teachers have been using the website DeltaMath (deltamath.com), which provides problems and helpful solutions for students in a wide variety of ways. Please create a student account by clicking on the For Students button and then clicking on Register. For the class codes, please refer to the list below and use the one for the grade level or class the student will be entering. Feel free to use any email address you feel is appropriate; however, we do ask that the student's proper full name be used when filling out the personal information portion of the account.

Once students have signed in to their account, they will see their "summer class," below which they will find their assignments. **The classes will be posted on Monday, June 3, and the work will be due on Monday, August 26, and will count toward the first-quarter grade.** Each assignment is divided into a variety of problem sets containing five problems per topic. If your son needs help or a refresher on a particular topic, there are videos and explanations contained in each problem set. To increase retention, we recommend the problem sets be worked on over a series of days or weeks, as we anticipate the entire summer assignment taking between 4 to 6 hours total depending on the proficiency level of the student.

Families, we thank you for your support and encouragement, as we are confident that with your son's attentiveness to his summer assignment, he will start on the right path in the Palma math program.
