

The 2021-22 Palma School Year is almost here: **welcome back!** We are overjoyed to welcome you to the 70th anniversary year of Palma School's strong tradition of excellence in education, where **knowledge**, **leadership**, and **service** set the standard for college prep learning, formation of Christian character and success for life! I would like to draw your attention to some events that are being planned for the start of this year to welcome you back to campus, and to welcome the *newest* members of our Palma Family.

"New" Students' Orientation Day (W, Aug. 11) – is facilitated by CORE upperclassmen led by Mr. Beesley and Mr. Sterrett. Our 6th-9th grade students are enthusiastically welcomed to new experiences as Chieftains! CORE forges friendships with our middle and high school students where they are mentored and celebrated. Students will participate in ice breakers, introductions, Palma pride-building exercises, and a scavenger hunt. Ultimately CORE (cor is Latin for "heart") aims to embrace new students to feel welcomed and important to the Palma Family, by their own upper class peers.

**New Parents' Orientation Day (W, Aug. 11)** – New parents are invited to meet with an array of administrators and directors, along with a tech orientation to help parents navigate the Palma world of iPads, online grades, digital postings of daily announcements, online calendar of events, digital books, safe access to internet on campus, and more. This event offers yet another opportunity for some "Q and A" from those assembled. Many new parents express gratitude on an annual basis for the efforts made at Palma to welcome them and their sons to school before the start of classes.

**ALL Students' Orientation Day (Th, Aug. 12) –** This is a mandatory event for all students, and the scheduled start times for each grade level is on page 8 of this newsletter. Students can expect this event to last for approximately one hour per grade level. Students are to report on time to the MPB when their grade level (class) orientation begins. Required athletic activity for all levels of high school sports will not begin earlier than 2:30pm this day. Revised student class schedules with more detailed information will be provided to each student. A teacher will address some features of the *Student & Parent Handbook*. Palma School locks will be sold, as lockers will be issued to students in grades 7-12. Yearbook sales and information will be available, along with opportunities to pick up last year's yearbook for returning students. A limited supply of gently used books, clothes and supplies will be sold by the Parents' Club. There will be no book sales on Orientation Day (no lines, no hassles); all books needed for the coming school year have been available for your purchase online. Students need to be prepared to take Student ID pictures in the Cislini Study Center (CSC); Lifetouch will email information directly to you if you choose to purchase pictures. P.E. uniforms will be sold during the first few days of school.

**First Day of Classes (F, Aug. 13) –** students can expect to have a minimum day schedule of classes followed by some fun high school activities with Palma and Notre Dame on the fields, and other activities for our middle school students in the gym. Students will be available for pickup that day any time between 2:30 and 3:00pm.






#### Palma Parking Lot Pick-up/Drop-off

When dropping off and/or picking up students please avoid entering the parking lot immediately before and/or after school as we simply do not have room for additional vehicles.

As nice as it is seeing parents early in the morning, it is preferred you drop off your son on Iverson or Acacia Street. When dropping off your favorite Palma student in the parking lot, please drive beyond the flag pole and be sure to pull over to the right to allow others to pass. Parents having business on campus who arrive after 8:30am are free to park in any unused parking spot.

Drivers waiting for students at the end of the school day should wait along Iverson Street beyond the bus zone or at some other pre-arranged location. Please avoid entering an already full Palma parking lot, double parking, or waiting in the red-marked, no-parking zone.

Students will report to the MPB at their designated time (above) for a presentation to begin each class orientation. Official student class schedules and information will be distributed on that day. Students will take school pictures; receive student ID cards, class schedules, lockers, and more. The Parents' Club will have a limited supply of used books and clothes at consignment prices, various Palma novelties (not used) will be provided by Ace High Designs, and the Athletics Department will have P.E. clothes and combination locks, all available for purchase. Yearbooks can be ordered on this day. Last year's yearbooks will also be available for pick up.

Students are expected to report on time to the MPB. The Palma Dress Code is in effect on Thursday, August 12th. Students are expected to arrive on campus properly dressed and groomed, in keeping with the code. Students may be withheld from school pictures and student ID cards if they are not groomed and dressed accordingly.

**Attending the Orientation Day is not optional** — official student attendance records begin Thursday, August 12, 2021.

Athletic activity for all levels of all fall sports will not begin earlier than 2:30 pm on Thursday, August 12th.

Students who have not already done so will need to bring to the main office: Request for Tdap, MMR (2 doses), Varicella (2 doses) and immunization record (NEW students only); copy of Birth Certificate (NEW students only); Ninth Grade Physical; Off-Campus Permission Form (Senior Class Only); and the Technology Acceptable Use Policy (ALL Students).

By now you have received the Sports Eligibility Packet from Palma Athletics. It is also available under "Quicklinks" on the website. The packet contains information regarding:

Physical exam – ALL studentathletes must undergo a physical exam in order to participate in sports. The Palma Athletic Council will offer sports physicals on Wednesday, August 4, 2021 from 6:00pm to 8:00pm for all Palma student-athletes, for a minimal fee of \$25. The completed physical exam form is a component of the Sports Eligibility Packet so take advantage of this opportunity! No appointment is necessary.

**Concussion testing** – A concussion test is required every two years in high school and every year in junior high. Student-athletes new to Palma, all freshmen and junior high student-athletes MUST take the test on campus. Seniors, Juniors and Sophomores who have completed a Palma concussion test in the past can take their test (if needed) online.

School-sanctioned combination locks and P.E. clothes will bed available at orientation on Thursday, August 12th. A flyer in the Athletic Packet provides prices and other information. Please note — ALL LOCKS USED ON CAMPUS MUST BE PURCHASED FROM PALMA.






