From the Principal

Let us be reminded of those, perhaps even among our own families, who need more of our gratitude, who need more of our love.

Dear People of Palma,

Gratitude, indeed, is a very rare virtue. Doesn't gratitude seem to be rarest among American culture today? People are always in a rush and we are more demanding than ever. Our wants have become our needs, and our luxuries have become our necessities. Having multiple televisions, multiple computers, multiple cellular and land-line phones, all in multiple rooms for multiple uses now seem to be our basic home necessities. We have grown so accustomed to them, we even feel *entitled* to them.

Schools are no exception to people who feel *entitled* with unrestricted access to them. After all, are we not *paying* for this education? Doesn't this mean, then, that I should be able to demand a teacher's time whenever I need it to discuss my needs and my son? Doesn't this mean that I can choose whenever my family deserves a vacation — even if it interrupts the routine for learning and school attendance so important to my son? If my son is uncomfortable with his educational experience, then I should be able to pull him out of school because, after all, my son is *entitled* to be happy all the time. If my son does a good deed, shouldn't he be *rewarded* for it? If I am in a hurry, (and parking is always a problem) don't I have the right to park wherever I want — even if it trumps fire lanes, school prohibited zones and parking spaces dedicated to Palma personnel and students with permits? And, of course, the office staff exists primarily to satisfy my needs and wants, so not only am I *entitled* to their time but I deserve a smile from them while they *serve me*.

Gratitude inspired from above translates into *caritas* — a love that moves us to act for others. We must be mindful of the many needs throughout our world filled with inequality. In gratitude for you all this Thanksgiving, go *Chieftains!*

November's the month for college applications

The college essay

This is your opportunity to tell the college about yourself — your hopes, ambitions, life experiences, inspirations. Take your time on this assignment. Be open. Be reflective. Find your individual voice and express it honestly.

Do's and Don'ts for your application

- Do use unique personal anecdotes. You want your application to stand out!
- Do get to know your universities and what they stand for before filling out your applications.
- Do follow directions given in your application, such as adhering to word or page limits. Read the question thoroughly and don't elicit information that was not requested.
- Don't procrastinate. Last minute, rushed applications will not reflect your best work.
- Don't lie. *Period*. Any fabricated grades or omitted grades, test scores, leadership positions admission counselors will find out and it will certainly jeopardize your acceptance and scholarships.

Other aid forms required by private colleges

Seniors applying to private colleges and universities should ensure that they complete all financial aid applications required by the school. Some private colleges require applicants to complete and submit the CSS Profile. For many colleges this form is due in early November. This form can be completed online at http://profileonline.collegeboard.com/index.jsp. Colleges that do not require the CSS Profile often require applicants to complete other university-specific financial

aid forms. Check with the Admissions and Financial Aid offices at the private colleges to which you are applying. Failure to do so could reduce the amount of financial aid you might receive.
